ARCHEO.FOSS XVIII | 2024

International conference on Open software, hardware, processes, data and formats in archaeological research

The 18th edition of ArcheoFOSS will be hosted at University G.D'Annunzio of Chieti-Pescara on **19-20 December 2024**.

This edition will be based on **panel sessions** that provide an opportunity for expert panel members to present their views and share their experience on a specific topic and then engage in a discussion with the audience.

We are welcoming original proposals from both community members and external scholars or professionals willing to discuss research questions and experience and stimulate further discussion of specific topics. As well-known, the ArcheoFOSS conference is traditionally focused on the dissemination of archaeological projects following the Open Science paradigm: open source software tools, open formats and open methodology both for investigation and dissemination.

Panels

Panellists, therefore, should clearly state how their proposal meets one or more of the following topics:

- Use and reuse of open software in archaeology.
- · Public archaeology: theory and methods.
- FOSS powered uses of Big Data
- Al applications in archaeology
- Reflection on communication in archaeology: tools, methods and case studies.

A typical panel session starts with a brief introduction by the panel chair, followed by the presentations of three or four panellists.

Proposals

Proposals for panels (see template below) **must** fully comply with the ArcheoFOSS mission, regarding free and open source software or hardware, open processes, open data, open science in the archaeological or more generally in the heritage domain. All proposals will be published in a not anonymous, peer-review process.

Proposals must be submitted via email, at <u>callforpaper@archeofoss.org</u> before **September 15 2024**, and must be licensed as CC-BY.

A maximum of **10 panels** will be accepted.

Proposal

must consist of a contribution of one (1) three (3) pages. The proposals must clearly illustrate the panel goals, which may concernthe presentation of specific topics. The theme of the panel is free and not bound to the conference tracks. Proposals may contain abrief reference bibliography, which however is not mandatory. Figures or tables may be included in the proposal.
